


AG. RECTOR'S Profile

Professor John B. K. Aheto schooled at the University of Ghana, where he holds a Bachelor of Science in Accounting from 1967 to 1970. He then went to New York University and was awarded an MBA in Accounting and Finance from 1971 to 1973. He again enrolled at New York University and pursed Accounting and Finance, M. Phil. & ABD between 1973 to 1978 but withdrew from the doctoral programme in the middle of the dissertation stage due to complications from two operations for slip disc -

He has over forty-five years of University teaching, research, consulting, and practical professional experience in Accounting, Auditing, Tax, Human Resource Development, Project Monitoring and Evaluation, and Finance in the USA (20 years) and Ghana (15 years). He taught at both graduate and undergraduate levels and did consulting works for many corporations in the USA. He was a member of the Board of Directors of the Pace University and Florida A&M University Small Business Development Centers in New York and Tallahassee and served on various universitywide committees.

In Ghana, he is involved in academic teaching, research, human resource development, training, consulting, program and project monitoring and evaluation, and micro-finance. He has been actively involved in consulting as an Associate Senior Consultant with other professional organizations. He is actively engaged in the development of SMEs and SME financing, and has served as a consultant to many businesses.

INTRODUCTION


As we commence another academic year, I warmly welcome all of you to the Matriculation ceremony of the 2023/24 academic year on behalf of the University College Council and the entire AUCRE community.

I acknowledge all freshmen and women who have enrolled for the year. I count you lucky as you have made it amidst this year's stringent admission process. Your decision to school at AUCRE indicates your taste for an entrepreneurial journey of skills acquisition, excellence and professionalism.

Matriculation at AUCRE provides a platform for all freshmen and women to be officially accepted to the University College as junior members and pledge your allegiance to the University College's authority through the administration of the **Matriculation Oath.** The Matriculation Oath equally enjoins the Management of the University College to prioritize students' welfare at all times.

ADMISSIONS

For the 2023/2024 academic year, 87 students were granted admission out of 94 applicants. 49 of these students have registered for the academic year. 71% of the registered students are males and 29% are females. 59% of the registered students were accepted into diploma programmes while the remaining 41% were enrolled in certificate programmes. This year, 4% of our students are international students.



FINANCIALAID

In 2022, the University College instituted the Rectors Scholarship Scheme as an inclusive measure and to significantly reduce the barriers limiting access to education at AUCRE. Through the scheme, 21 students have benefitted up to 50% scholarship this year. This brings to total, 41 students who have benefitted from the scheme since its inception.

NEW STUDENTS' PORTAL

AUCRE, despite being a young institution, is committed to digital transformation in today's era of rapid technological advancement. In this regard, the University College will witness the launch of the new students' portal. The students' portal will be user-friendly to enhance accessibility, communication and overall students' digital experience. The portal will be linked to the AUCRE website for easy access to students' information and resources.

ACHIEVEMENTS

The University College has obtained Authorization from the Ghana Tertiary Education Commission (GTEC) and is expected to complete the accreditation process within 3 years. Distinguished ladies and gentlemen, the Council and Management of the University College are working assiduously to ensure the accreditation is obtained within the aforementioned period. Preparations are also ongoing concurrently to ensure the University College obtains accreditation for a center from the Commission for Technical and Vocational Education and Training (CTVET) in the shortest possible time.

The University College is now affiliated to the Institute of Commercial Management-UK. This affiliation has opened a world breaking record door for the institution. Ladies and gentlemen, I am pleased to inform you that for the first time in the history of the Institute of Commercial Management-UK, final/external examinations were held in the Volta Region, specifically at the Adonai University College of Research and Entrepreneurship. In the past, ICM-UK students from the Volta Region had to travel to Accra to sit for their final examinations. The narrative has, however, changed as a result of the establishment of AUCRE in the Volta Region through the hard work of the University College Council and Management.

NEWACADEMIC PROGRAMMES

AUCRE is pleased to introduce the Research Insight Summit 24, a 3-months' duration course in April this year. This course seeks to train corporate workers, academic staff, employers and students in modern research and data collection, analysis and management methods for business development. Another programme newly introduced by the University College is the 3-months Certificate in Business Sustainability Training for SMEs in Ghana. This course was introduced

The University College will in the immediate future also introduce the Chartered Institute of Logistics and Transport programme. Ladies and gentlemen, the two new programmes are tailored towards the dynamic needs of today's business world. I am confident that many persons of the working class and students in the Region and beyond will take advantage of this opportunity.

INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS

Despite the national economic challenges, the AUCRE main campus physical infrastructure development is ongoing as planned. This includes two buildings – one multipurpose story building which will comprise offices and lecture halls; and another one-story building purposed for lecture hall usage. The University College is confident of completing these projects within the shortest possible time.

In addition, the University College has completed the Golf City View Restaurant Annex (GCVR/AUCRE Gardens) which is in operation. The restaurant is serving the University College community's cafeteria needs as well as the public.
